About today's organist:

Peter H. Fyne, ARCT, A.Mus., ARCCO, was appointed organist and accompanist of Immanuel United Church in September 2010. Previously he served for nearly 22 years as organist & pianist of First Church of Christ, Scientist (Winnipeg). Peter has served as accompanist for the Irish Association of Manitoba Choir ("Irish Myst Choir" for short) since 2014, and has directed the Shalom Singers choir (under the auspices of the Rose & Max Rady Jewish Community Centre) since 2019.

Peter joined the RCCO in 1989 and has been an active member of the Winnipeg Centre since 1992, serving primarily in the capacities of secretary, treasurer, vice president and president. Currently he is the Centre's vice president and archivist. Peter has performed at numerous RCCO Winnipeg Centre events over the years - most recently the annual Bach Marathons held at Young United Church.
